



## E. PAUL TORRANCE CREATIVITY AWARD

The Georgia Association for Gifted Children's *E. Paul Torrance Creativity Award* recognizes outstanding achievement in areas related to the study and/or promotion of creativity. Any individual (student, parent, teacher, administrator, or community leader) who has advanced the lifelong work of Dr. E. Paul Torrance through scholarly research on creativity, individual creative productivity, or helping in the recognition and development of creative potential in others is eligible for this award.

### Criteria:

#### **1. Impact (past, current, or potential)**

The contributions of this individual should have significant impact over time. The sustained efforts of nominees shall have positively influenced others – either directly or through a ripple effect - and/or show promise for continued influence on the field and/or the creativity of others (e.g., students, teachers, other professionals). Preference will be given to nominees whose work has had (or shows strong potential to have) a positive impact on gifted students in the state of Georgia.

#### **2. Relationship to Dr. Torrance's work**

The contribution(s) of this individual should have a clear relationship to one or more areas of Dr. Torrance's work. These include, but are not limited to: creative problem solving; Future Problem Solving; assessing and identifying creativity, including use of the *Torrance Tests of Creative Thinking*; recognition of creative strengths in economically disadvantaged students; mentoring; developing creativity in students, especially those from underserved populations; the *Incubation Model of Teaching*; and other types of creative curriculum.

### Procedure:

The nomination packet must include:

- 1) Completed nomination form (next page)
- 2) Explanation of nominator's relationship to the nominee
- 3) Brief listing of nominee's accomplishments related to the study and/or promotion of creativity
- 4) Narrative summary, not to exceed one typed page, of the nominee's specific contributions toward the recognition, acceptance, and development of creativity
- 5) Two letters of support for the nomination

### Recognition:

The award recipient will be recognized at the annual GAGC convention. He or she will receive a complimentary registration to this year's convention, a plaque presented at the convention, and a letter of recognition from the GAGC President.

**Nominations shall be submitted by November 30.**
