CHAPTER OF THE YEAR

Criteria: The chapter must:

- 1) be affiliated with GAGC and be in good standing
- 2) not have won this award in the past five years

Procedure: Nominated chapter must submit documentation to support evaluation of the following areas:

- 1) Contributions the chapter has made to the local gifted program (time, money, resources, mentors, etc.)
- 2) Contributions to total educational program (time, money, resources, mentors, etc.)
- 3) Special projects
- 4) Methods for communicating to teachers, parents, and others in the local system
- 5) How well chapter activities have met chapter goals
- 6) Facilitation of involvement of the membership at large in activities/projects of the chapter
- 7) Programs planned and implemented during the current and past school year
- 8) Some sense of the percentage of educators and parents who are current members

Recognition: Awardees will be acknowledged with a certificate, presented at the annual convention, and a letter of recognition from the GAGC President.
