NICHOLAS GREEN DISTINGUISHED STUDENT AWARD for the State of Georgia

Sponsored by the National Association for the Gifted

The Nicholas Green Foundation was established by Maggie and Reg Green to honor the memory of their son, Nicholas, whom they lost at age seven. The Foundation has made this award available to one student in every state who is in grades 3 through 6 and who has distinguished him/herself in academics, leadership, or the arts. Students may self-nominate or be nominated by another individual. The award will consist of a certificate and a \$500 savings bond.

Criteria:

Please include the following items with the student's application:

- Two letter(s) of recommendation from someone other than a nominee's family members, such as a teacher or principal, explaining why the student is deserving of the award, what sets him or her apart from others, and how the nominee is impacting others.
- Current school photo — no photocopies of photos, and no photos larger than 2x3 inches.
- **A 750-word composition written by the student must address all four questions:** (1) what is the activity or interest area for which the student is being nominated; (2) how did the student become interested/involved in the activity; (3) what impact has the activity had on the student and on others; and (4) how have the student's future plans and goals been affected by this activity or interest area.
- A Release Form completed and signed by a parent or guardian

Recognition: Awardees will be acknowledged with a certificate, presented at the annual convention, and a letter of recognition from the GAGC President.

Awardees will be acknowledged with a certificate, presented at the annual convention, and a letter of recognition from the GAGC President. Their names will be added to the Leadership Award recipient's plaque maintained by the organization and displayed at the annual conference.
